Serological test

Swab after a positive serological test



IGG-IGM quantitative serological test There is only one test per member.

It is generally accepted that a medical prescription is not required unless it is given at the regional level, for the member to request a "Quantitative serological test IGG-IGM" at an affiliated facility must:

- A consult the list of approved facilities for serological testing (available at <a href="https://www.fondosanedil.it/en/covid-19-emergency-campaign/">https://www.fondosanedil.it/en/covid-19-emergency-campaign/</a>);
- B locate the facility and contact the chosen centre by telephone;
- book the appointment independently;
- apply to the relevant Cassa Edile/EdilCassa by submitting:

  THE APPLICATION FORM, on which you must indicate the affiliated facility and the date and time of the appointment.

To request a "Quantitative IGG- IGM serological test" **at a non-contracted facility** (NB: only if the enrolled worker is domiciled in a province that does not have contracted health facilities), the member must:

- A take the Test;
- **B** apply to the relevant Cassa Edile/EdilCassa by submitting:
  - CLAIM FORM;
  - QUANTITATIVE SEROLOGICAL TEST INVOICE.



## Nasopharyngeal swab for RNA after positive serological test

Without prejudice to the need for a prescription from the general practitioner or specialist, which must be delivered to the facility on the day of the appointment, unless otherwise specified at a regional level, to request a "Nasopharyngeal swab for RNA research" at a participating facility, the member must:

- A consult the list of approved facilities for serological testing;
- B locate the facility and contact the chosen centre by telephone;
- book the appointment independently;
- papply to the relevant Cassa Edile/Edilcassa by presenting:
  - AUTHORISATION FORM for post-serological swab;
  - POSITIVE SEROLOGICAL TEST REPORT.

To request a "Nasopharyngeal swab for RNA research" **at a non-contracted facility** (NB: only if the registered worker is domiciled in a province with no contracted health facilities), the member must:

- A take the Test;
- B apply to the relevant Cassa Edile/EdilCassa by submitting:
  - CLAIM FORM;
  - SWAB INVOICE:
  - COPY OF THE PRESCRIPTION of the general practitioner or specialist doctor;
  - REPORT OF POSITIVE RESULT on serological test or report of a positive result on the previous swab.

In the event of a positive result on the first swab, the member may, following the procedures described above, request a further swab(s) following the timetable established by the treating doctor to verify recovery.

In the latter case, the member must submit to the Cassa Edile/EdilCassa, in addition to the required documentation, the report of the positive result of the previous swab, in place of the report of the serological test.
